STATE ROUTE 99 DETOUR PLANNED AT HERNDON AVENUE UNDERCROSSING

WHAT: FULL CLOSURE AT HERNDON AVENUE/STATE ROUTE 99 UNDERCROSSING AS PART OF THE STATE ROUTE 99 WIDENING PROJECT.

WHEN: BEGINNING TUESDAY EVENING, NOVEMBER 16TH THROUGH FRIDAY MORNING, NOVEMBER 19TH FROM 7:00 P.M UNTIL 5:00 A.M. NIGHTLY.

WHERE: IN FRESNO; AT THE HERNDON AVENUE STATE ROUTE 99 UNDERCROSSING

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and DeSilva Construction announce a full closure of Herndon Ave. below the State Route (SR) 99 overcrossing as part of the **North Fresno Six-Lane SR 99 Widening Project currently in construction.** This closure is necessary in order to implement structure improvements at this location. As part of this improvement project, the following detours will be in place during this time frame:

- **From northbound SR99 to Grantland Ave:**
Continue on northbound SR 99; exit at Ave. 7 (Exit 144) turn left; enter southbound SR 99, exit southbound Grantland Ave. (Exit 142) off-ramp (right turn only);continue to Grantland Ave.
- **From southbound SR 99 to eastbound Herndon Ave:**
Exit Herndon Ave. (Exit 143) southbound off-ramp to Goldenstate Blvd; continue eastbound on Herndon.
- **From westbound Herndon Ave. to Grantland Ave. / southbound SR 99:**
From Herndon, turn right on Golden State Blvd; continue northbound on SR 99; exit at Ave. 7, (Exit 144) turn left; enter southbound State Route 99; continue or exit southbound Grantland Ave. (Exit 142) off-ramp (right turn only).
- **From Grantland Ave. to eastbound Herndon Ave. / northbound SR 99:**
Access southbound SR 99 at Herndon/Grantland Ave, on-ramp; exit Shaw Ave (Exit 140); turn right; access northbound SR 99 loop on-ramp to Herndon Ave. off-ramp or access Goldenstate Blvd; continue northbound.

Current schedule subject to change due to unforeseen contractor operations. **Motorists should use an alternate route whenever possible.** Caltrans would like to thank the residents and commuters for their patience during this improvement project.
