CALTRANS ANNOUNCES SOUTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 99 RAMPS TO BE CLOSED FOR CONSTRUCTION

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and Security Paving, Inc. announce a scheduled closure of the southbound State Route (SR) 99 Avenue 12 on and off-ramps in Madera County as part of the on-going **State Route 99 Avenue 12 Interchange Improvement Project**. Ramp closures are necessary to allow construction crews to conduct drainage basin operations at this location for the next 30-working days; **Monday-Friday from 5:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. each day. (No weekends or holidays)**

The following ramps will be closed each day beginning next week, Monday, June 10th:

- **Southbound (SB) State Route (SR) 99 off-ramp to Avenue 12**

Suggested Detour:

Exit Almond Avenue; turn right; proceed to SR 145; turn left onto Avenue 12.

- **Southbound (SB) State Route (SR) 99 Avenue 12 loop on-ramp**

Suggested Detour:

Continue west onto Avenue 12; turn left onto Road 28; turn left onto Avenue 9; continue to southbound SR 99 on-ramp.

Scheduled closures are subject to contractor schedule and weather permitting. Ramp closures may continue for longer periods of time if necessary due to delays caused by unforeseen weather conditions or uncontrollable events which may occur during construction.

Caltrans would like to thank the residents, businesses and commuters for their patience during this improvement project. The public is asked to drive with extra care while traveling through this construction area, and please **Slow for the Cone Zone at all times.**
