LANE CLOSURE ON STATE ROUTE 99 NEAR GOSHEN SCHEDULED FOR NEXT WEEK

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces a scheduled lane closure on southbound State Route 99, from just north of Betty Drive to the Avenue 328 overcrossing near Goshen in Tulare County to allow construction crews to repair and replace changeable message sign on outside shoulder.

The following lane closure is scheduled to take place next week, (weather permitting):

Southbound State Route 99, #2 lane (right lane) near Goshen, just north of Betty Drive to Avenue 328 overcrossing, will be closed Tuesday evening, December 18th through Friday morning, December 21st, 2012 between the hours of 6:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. each night.

State Route 99 will be reduced to one lane in this area during work times. Commuters will experience delays and are encouraged to avoid this area and use alternate routes if possible.

This construction work is planned weather permitting. Should weather allow, crews will complete construction within 1-2 working nights, however, due to forecasted storms, 2-3 working nights may be necessary.

Caltrans Construction workers remind you to drive with extra care and allow additional travel time while traveling through this closure.
