NORTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 99 RAMP AND LANE CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR NEXT WEEK

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces a scheduled closure of the #3 lane (slow lane) on northbound State Route 99 from Olive Drive to the State Route 65 overcrossing and will include the closures of the Olive Drive northbound on-ramp, the Norris northbound on-ramp and the northbound off-ramp to State Route 65, within the Bakersfield city limits, in Kern County. These closures will be necessary to allow Maintenance crews to conduct asphalt rehabilitation operations in the #3 lane at these locations.

The following closures are scheduled for next week, Monday, April 11 and Tuesday, April 12, 2011 (weather permitting):

The #3 lane (slow lane) on northbound State Route 99 from Olive Drive to the State Route 65 overcrossing, within the Bakersfield city limits, will be closed Monday, April 11 and Tuesday, April 12, 2011 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. each day. This lane closure will also include the closures of the Olive Drive northbound on-ramp, the Norris northbound on-ramp and the northbound off-ramp to State Route 65.

This scheduled closure will occur, weather permitting. Closures may continue for longer periods of time if necessary, due to delays caused by weather or uncontrollable events that may occur during maintenance.

Caltrans Maintenance workers would like to thank the local residents, businesses and commuters for their patience and remind you to drive with extra care and allow additional travel time while travelling on State Route 99. Please be alert for Road Maintenance Personnel and **“Slow for the Cone Zone.”**
