CALTRANS ANNOUNCES RAMP CLOSURE NEXT WEEK

WHAT: CONSTRUCTION GRINDING, PAVING AND STRIPING PROJECT AT STANISLAUS STREET SOUTHBOUND OFF-RAMP.

WHEN: BEGINNING MONDAY NIGHT, APRIL 15TH –APRIL 16TH FROM 8:00 P.M. UNTIL 6:00 A.M. EACH MORNING.

WHERE: FRESNO COUNTY; SOUTHBOUND STANISLAUS STREET OFF-RAMP TO JUST NORTH OF TUOLUMNE STREET.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces *Lee's Paving, Inc.* will conduct a grinding and paving improvement project at the southbound Stanislaus State Route (SR) 99 off-ramp for approximately two nights beginning next week. In order to minimize traffic impacts during regular commute times, this project will consist of overnight ramp and shoulder closures and will include flagger personnel along Stanislaus Street in order to safely conduct this improvement project. This project is anticipated to be completed in two evenings with the contractor concluding final striping approximately one-week later. **(Schedule subject to change due to schedule or unforeseen circumstances.)**

Motorists may experience traffic delays in this area during this time and are advised to use an alternate route/ramp and to allow extra time to their evening or early morning commute. Portable Changeable Message Signs (PCMS) will be in place along southbound State Route 99 notifying motorists of upcoming ramp and shoulder closures.

Caltrans would like to thank commuters, businesses and residents for their patience during this improvement project. The public is reminded to be alert for construction personnel and to adhere to all construction signage at/near this location. The safety of our motorists' and work crew personnel is most important, therefore, please stay alert and "**Slow for the Cone Zone**" in all Construction and Maintenance Zones at all times.
