STATE ROUTE 99 OFF-RAMP TO BE CLOSED DUE TO MAINTENANCE

WHAT: FULL RAMP CLOSURE DUE TO MAINTENANCE PAVEMENT REPAIR.
WHEN: MONDAY, FEBRUARY 11TH FROM 7:00 A.M. UNTIL 3:00 P.M. (1-DAY)
WHERE: COUNTY OF FRESNO; KAMM/BETHEL AVENUE OFF-RAMP
FROM SOUTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 99.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces maintenance crews will implement pavement repair operations at the southbound State Route 99 off-ramp to Kamm & Bethel Avenues. This off-ramp is located just south the city of Selma and just north of the City of Kingsburg. In order to safely implement this project the #3 slow lane (closest to the right shoulder) will also be closed. Signage will be in place advising motorists of the upcoming lane closure and full ramp closure. (Weather Permitting)

The public is reminded to drive with extra care while travelling through maintenance and construction projects at all times and to adhere to all posted signage.
