CALTRANS ANNOUNCES MAINTENANCE PROJECT ALONG SOUTHBOUND 99

WHAT: EMERGENCY SLAB REPLACEMENT PROJECT ALONG SOUTHBOUND 99
WHEN: FRIDAY, JUNE 6th, 10:00 P.M. UNTIL 6:00 A.M. SATURDAY MORNING
WHERE: CITY OF FRESNO; SOUTHBOUND 99 FROM JUST SOUTH OF BELMONT AVENUE TO JUST SOUTH OF ELDORADO STREET

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces maintenance personnel will conduct emergency slab replacements within the **southbound (SB)** number one (fast) and number two (middle) lane of State Route (SR) 99 tomorrow evening beginning at 10:00 p.m. **(Schedule or specific lane closures are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances which may occur during maintenance operations.)**

Traffic delays are expected along southbound SR99 during this time as only ONE LANE, or the number three (slow) lane, closest to the right shoulder will be accessible to motorists within the work zone. It is anticipated that on and off-ramps within the project limits will remain open. Motorists are encouraged to avoid the area or use an alternate route whenever possible.

In partnership with the California Highway Patrol (CHP), CHP enforcement will be present to provide extra support for traffic control. Permanent and portable changeable message signs (CMS) will be activated north of the project limits notifying motorists to expect delays.

Caltrans would like to thank motorists for their patience during this emergency project. The public is reminded to be alert for Caltrans personnel and to merge when directed to do so. The safety of our motorists' and work crew personnel is most important, therefore, please stay alert and "**Slow for the Cone Zone**" in all Construction and Maintenance Zones at all times.
