WHAT: NIGHTTIME LANE CLOSURES AND CONSTRUCTION FOR REHABILITATION OF SOUTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 99 AT THE KINGS RIVER BRIDGE

WHEN: BEGINNING TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 9, 2008

WHERE: IN TULARE COUNTY, SOUTH OF THE CITY OF KINGSBURG

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in cooperation with Professional Construction Services (PCS) announces the beginning of construction of the State Route 99 Kings River Bridge Rehabilitation Project. The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate Southbound State Route 99 at the Kings River Bridge, which will include removal of asphalt concrete surface of bridge deck, replacement of roadway surface with concrete overlay, replacement of existing bridge approach decks, upgrades to current guardrail transitions and replacement of weather station sensors and temperature probes on the bridge structure. This project is scheduled to be completed in October 2008.

There will be nighttime lane closures on State Route 99 this week. During nighttime lane closures, the public may experience 15-minute delays with one lane of southbound traffic in operation. Nighttime lane closures for next week are as follows:

6:00 p.m. - 6:00 a.m. Tuesday evening, September 9, 2008 thru Friday morning, September 12, 2008

No traffic restrictions on the evenings of Friday, September 12, 2008 or Saturday, September 13, 2008.
