

Project Purpose:

This project will rehabilitate the existing pavement and widen the shoulders of State Route 41. This project will extend the life of the current roadway and bring the roadway up to present Caltrans Standards. The project will improve mobility and enhance traffic safety within this section of State Route 41.

Project Description:

The project is on State Route 41 near Lemoore from Hanford/Armona Road to just north of Grangeville Boulevard. This project will replace the existing pavement, within the project limits, to match the pavement to the South of the project limits that was previously rehabilitated. This project will also raise the profile grade to match the existing southbound profile and replace the existing pavement on northbound lanes of State Route 41 in Kings County.

Construction Cost: \$7.5 Million

Begin Construction: July 2012

End of Construction: December 2013
