### Mono Thin Blanket

*Mono County* – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin the Mono Thin Blanket project on August 12, 2013. This project will place a hot mix asphalt overlay, place a shoulder backing, replace the drainage systems and paint traffic stripes. Various locations along SR 120, SR 167 and US Hwy 395 will receive these treatments.

Drivers should anticipate daily lane closures along US Hwy 395 Monday – Thursday from 6:00 am to 7:00 pm and on Friday's from 6:00 am to 3:00 pm. There should be minimum delays due to the work being performed.

Along SR 120 & SR 167 drivers will encounter one way reversing lane closures with flaggers and a pilot car. Construction hours are scheduled to be Monday – Thursday from 6:00 am to 7:00 pm and on Friday's from 6:00 am to 3:00 pm. Drivers may encounter up to 20 minute delays.

This project is scheduled to be completed by October 2013.

The contractor for this \$4,238,324 project is Granite Construction of Bakersfield, CA.

For the safety of the construction crew and motorists, please be attentive to closures, slow for the cone zone, and move over one lane where possible.
