Hello, I have been renting a Caltrans house for over 20 years. After many years of struggling to raise a child by myself, I am finally making more than median income (including many hours of overtime) and thus find that I do not supposedly qualify to purchase my house. I don't understand why a public or private affordable housing organization is being given priority to purchase the home before me. I still can't afford to buy in South Pasadena where the median income is over \$90,000. I have asked Caltrans to sell me the house many times over the years before I was making more than median income. I believe I should be offered the house prior to your giving it to a housing organization. Where am I going to be able to find a place to live. I am now over 65 and plan to go part time where I will be making less than median income. I think this should be taken into account when deciding if I qualify (not by looking at my last year's income tax return but looking at what I will actually be making shortly).
