Dear Brent L. Green and Ms. Jennifer Lowden,

I appreciate the California Department of Transportation's willingness to hear comments by tenant's to ensure a favorable outcome for the sale of surplus SR-710 properties. While the new proposed regulations address several of the issues in the initial public comment period, I would like to request that CalTrans amend the new proposed rules and regulations of the Affordable Sales Program as follows:

1. 'Ownership in Real Property within the last three years,' be removed as any part of the conditions to qualify under the Affordable Sales Program.

The reasons for removal are:

1. Tax returns and other income-related documents, not ownership in real property, provide an accurate description of a prospective buyer's financial status.
2. The condition is against the spirit of the Roberti bill
 - a. Ownership in real-estate should be encouraged rather than discouraged
 - b. Ownership in property is not a clear indication of net-income.
 - c. The cost of living has risen dramatically since the bill was created twenty years ago, particularly in neighborhoods along the SR-710 corridor.
