California Bicycle Advisory Committee
Charter

Mission

The primary mission of the California Bicycle Advisory Committee (CBAC) is to ensure that the mission, policies, programs, and operations of the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) meet the needs of those who travel by bicycle in California.

Goals and values

The CBAC shall support the goals and values of Caltrans to improve mobility and provide a safe and efficient transportation system across California by:

- Improving bicyclist safety and reducing bicyclist injuries and fatalities.
- Increasing bicyclist access and mode share in California consistent with Caltrans goals, values, and policies.
- Educating and enhancing the awareness of Caltrans, its workforce and the public about the needs of bicyclists.

Responsibilities and tasks

- Advise Caltrans on standards and policies, including their revision, related to bicycling.
- Serve as a forum to review and evaluate proposals of responsible agencies concerned with bicycling.
- Review proposed legislation related to bicycling.
- Review proposed actions by the California Traffic Control Devices Committee related to bicycling.
- Review Caltrans and local agency planning and design documents as they relate to bicycling.
- Provide input and share information regarding existing major deficiencies and needed upgrades that affect bicyclist access.
- Provide input to Caltrans on designs, concepts, standards, and manuals related to bicycle facilities and for consideration to incorporate into existing Caltrans standards or manuals.

The committee shall meet at least six times a year.

Membership criteria and requirements

Committee membership shall comprise organizations and agencies whose mission relates directly to or benefits from bicycling. Membership may fluctuate depending on the needs of Caltrans or the committee.
