BACKGROUND: This is a follow-up to the workshops held in August that introduced the two transit programs being funded by Senate Bill 862 from proceeds from the Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund. The Transit and Intercity Rail Capital Program and the Low Carbon Transit Operations Program will fund local agencies transit projects that will reduce emissions through new or expanded bus or rail services, integration of rail and bus systems, modernize California's intercity, commuter, and urban rail systems, and will benefit disadvantaged communities. This workshop will update the participants on the status of the guidelines, the process, and timelines for these programs.
