- Measure I reauthorization recognizing CTSA

# SANBAG Ad-Hoc Steering Committee


- Appointed by SANBAG Board President

# SANBAG Transit and Rail Committee and Full Board

- Transit and Rail Committee – 11 members, 5 are Omnitrans Board Members - Overlap
- CTSA Agenda items presented to committee 3 times
- Board approved CTSA non-profit formation
- Board approved CTSA by-laws and articles of incorporation
- Board will approve CTSA designation

# Service Comparison

## Fixed Route

- ▣ Run by Omnitrans
- ▣ Mass Transit for all including seniors and disabled
- ▣ Established Routes
- ▣ Set run times
- ▣ Very structured by design

# Service Comparison

## Access (ADA Paratransit) Services

- ▣ Mandated by law
- ▣ Contracted out
- ▣ Mirrors fixed route in times and service area
- ▣ Negotiated trips
- ▣ Higher Cost and Higher Fare
- ▣ Includes Subscription
- ▣ Passenger must be certified to use

# Service Comparison

## Social Service Transportation

- ▣ People Centric
- ▣ Based on Social Services needs
- ▣ In support of fixed route and ADA service
- ▣ Alternatives to Subscription
- ▣ As flexible as need by
- ▣ Mix of funding streams – Transit and Social Service
- ▣ Creative solutions based upon need

# Implementation Schedule

- August
  - SANBAG Board Approves establishment of new Non-Profit
- September
  - SANBAG Board designates new Non-profit as CTSA
  - SANBAG appoints Floyd Petersen, Mike Bair and Gary Madden as incorporating Board of Directors
- October
  - CTSA establishes business functions

  - 2 Board appointees each
- May be elected official
- Cannot be employees of the agency
