LCTOP is one of several programs established by Senate Bill 862, approved by the California Legislature in 2014. Approved projects in LCTOP will support new and expanded bus and rail services, expand intermodal transit facilities, and may include equipment acquisition, fueling, maintenance and other costs to operate those services and facilities, with each project reducing greenhouse gas emissions.
