Subject: Out-of-State Travel Reduction

The Governor recently directed State departments and agencies to implement specific measures to save State expenditures. This directive includes a 75 percent reduction in State-funded out-of-state travel for the current fiscal year.

While the Department has already expended more than 25 percent of out-of-state travel State budget authority, the Department will strive to come as close as possible to a 75 percent reduction in State expenditures. Effective immediately, all districts and divisions are directed to implement the following actions:

- All State-funded travel that has not been previously approved has been suspended. A complete listing of previously approved travel by deputy director and district is attached. This listing identifies approved travel March – June 2003. The only exception to this may be unforeseen travel deemed essential by executive management and travel funded by others. These exceptions will require approval by the appropriate deputy director or district director and then must be approved by the Chief Deputy Director.
- Travel funded by others should be deemed essential, program or project related, **and** clearly provide benefit to the Department.
- Out-of-country travel funded by others will only be considered for the following business essential situations:
  1. Inspection of materials used on specific projects.
  2. Meetings regarding the security of Californians and infrastructures.
  3. Bordering states issues (Mexico/Canada).

As unforeseen State-funded critical travel arises, please review this listing for your functional area to find a similar purpose State-funded trip of lower priority that can be used as a substitute for the critical travel.

Please be reminded that any travel, regardless of the funding source, to resort areas (Reno or Las Vegas, Nevada; Orlando, Florida) and Washington, D.C. will require approval by the Business, Transportation and Housing Agency. Out-of-country travel (including travel to Hawaii and Alaska) will require further approvals through the Department of Finance and Governor's Office. These travel requests must be submitted at least ten weeks in advance of the proposed travel.

We are each responsible for requesting only essential out-of-state travel regardless of the funding source.
