Furthermore, Military and Veterans Code §999 (b) (7) (B) (ii) states: "*The management and control of the daily business operations are by one or more disabled veterans*". The disabled veterans who exercise management and control are not required to be the same disabled veterans as the owners of the business (emphasis added).

Since we have determined your firm is not providing a CUF for the specified classification listed in this letter, the DVBE credit will not be given toward the DVBE goal on a Caltrans State funded contract.

You may review your firm's information on the Department of General Services (DGS) website at <http://www.bidsync.com/DPXBisCASB>. It is your responsibility to maintain correct information regarding your firm's name, address, phone/fax number, and e-mail address on the DGS website.
