Subject: Use of "SLOW FOR THE CONE ZONE" SC20(CA) Sign in Construction Projects

"Slow for the Cone Zone" is a statewide education and public awareness campaign that focuses on educating California motorists about the hazards associated with driving recklessly through California's highway work zones. Because of the success of the "Slow for the Cone Zone" campaign, the Department will incorporate the campaign into selected construction projects so that the traveling public can further make the connection between the media campaign and the actual work zones.

Please review Attachment 1, "Selected Ongoing Projects," and identify a minimum of two projects in each district on which to place "SLOW FOR THE CONE ZONE" SC20(CA) signs. If your district is not on or does not show enough projects on the list, please select two projects that will benefit from the use of these signs.

Execute a change order and direct the contractor to place the SC20(CA) signs as part of the lane closure traffic controls for the duration of the project. Attachment 2, "SC20," includes details regarding the legend and size of the SC20(CA) sign. Attachment 3, "List of Possible Vendors," is a list of sign manufacturers. Attachment 4, "Typical Application 32"; Attachment 5, "Typical Application 33"; and Attachment 6, "Typical Application 36," provide details for placement of signs. Attachment 7 (form CEM-4903, "Contract Change Order Memorandum") and Attachment 8 (form CEM-4900, "Contract Change Order") also show the method of compensating the contractor for performing this work.
