Question:

What is the potential or need for Environmental support services for Risk Analysis, budget, scope etc. in support of Project Management?

Answer:

No, Environmental support services will be provided by the districts Environmental branches using district staff or environmental consultants on other contracts.

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Question:

1. Is the Budget planned expense to be equal each year?
2. For District 5 can the services be provided by Planners and Engineers?

Answer:

1. It is expected that the workload for each year of the contact will be constant so the estimate is essentially the same for each year.
2. Yes, the services can be provided by Planners and Engineers. The specific requirements for classification will be detailed in the Scope of Work.

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Consultants: Write a question you'd like to have answered during the Conference in the blank below.

Question:

Will a contract solicitation like the one for PPM services (valued at under \$3 million over 3 years) require that the prime provide a cognizant overhead audit as part of the SOQ/proposal, interview, or negotiation process?

Answer:

No. A cognizant overhead audit is never required for a Caltrans A&E contract.

Caltrans has a requirement for an independently audited overhead on certain A&E contracts. This requirement only applies to the Prime consultant (not to subconsultants) on an A&E contract and the total contract amount must be \$3.5 million or greater. This does not apply to the District 5, 6, and 10 PPM contract.
