

Traffic Control labor is based in general a minimum of 2-Manned and 1 TC Truck by Mallard Construction in traffic right of ways, unless otherwise noted or scope of work is variance. Additional laborers and other Equipment may apply depending on scope of work and time frame available for setup and teardown. Cost is based and subject to per move-in or teardown. Hours calculated for labor begins and ends from portal to portal (from hub at Mallard Construction in Orange, CA to destination at job site, and return back to hub at Mallard Construction in Orange, CA. Non-Maintaining is two shifts of a minimum of 4 hours portal to portal depending on distance and location. If more than 65 miles from hub to location, and 2 or more consecutive days of work, per diem of \$75.00 per man applies per day after first mobilization and completed ending work day. Travel time for per diem will reduce to less than 1 hour each direction. Overtime rates will apply if exceeding work time given and portal to portal time exceeds predicted time. The Contractor is responsible for pre-submittles, aquiring all permits, and notifying and advising agencies and residents of appending proposed work.

Traffic Control quantities of signs and other equipment are based on the TC Plans provided, or the diagrams and descriptions provided by the contractor. Equipment quantities, or additional, or minus equipment may be subjected to change based on change in scope of work, layout, or recomendations. Purchasing of signs and other equipment based on per unit sale cost. Total cost is based on actual quantities to be purchased and per unit sale cost will remain as presented in original proposal/ quote. Any other equipment, newly added or additional requirements, that are not listed/ indicated in the original proposal/ quote will be subjected to current sale cost per unit. All rentalable items are based on per unit cost by day, week, and 28 days cycle. Replacement of any damage, missing, or stolen equipment is subjected to re-purchasing cost.
