



- We are a union signatory and all labor agreements apply
- Add twenty four dollars a day per person in subsistence areas
- Traffic control over 300 cones will result in additional crew/s unless otherwise agreed upon
- Invoices are net 14 - past due invoices will accrue 1.5% interest monthly
- Customer/prime contractor will be liable for any legal fees related to the debt collection process
- Work periods less than 3 consecutive days add 10%
- Cancellations and short shifts with less than 24 hours notice will be charged as a full day.
