Caltrans and California State Parks—a Partnership for Multi-project Mitigation

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Project Details

- Caltrans was able to establish a multi-project mitigation site--meanwhile California State Parks (CSP) received financial support to fully construct their planned but unfunded, stream-wetland complex restoration.
- Caltrans mitigated the impacts from four projects to jurisdictional wetlands and waters. Approximately 2.5 acres of wetland habitat and 0.3 acres of Waters of the US were re-established within the CSP Inglenook Fen – Ten Mile Dunes Natural Preserve, in coastal Mendocino County.
- An Interagency Agreement facilitated the transaction between Agencies. Caltrans transferred monies to CSP to implement, monitor and maintain the mitigation in perpetuity.

Culverts and roadbed within the dune system were removed to restore both stream channel and adjacent wetlands.

All four Caltrans projects requiring mitigation, and the mitigation site itself, were located within the same watershed (8-digit hydrologic unit code (HUC)).
