Dear Mr. Knight:

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) received a bid submitted by Shasta Services, Inc., dba Timberworks (Timberworks) for Contract No. 01-0C1304 on March 27, 2013. By this letter, Caltrans notifies Timberworks that its bid is nonresponsive because it revised column 2 of the Subcontractor List form by adding a new scope of work on the 24-hour submission of the form.

The Subcontractor List form states in part, "...Complete columns 1 and 4 and submit with the bid. Complete columns 2 and 3 and submit with the bid or fax to (916) 227-6282 within 24 hours after the bid opening. Failure to provide complete information in columns 1 through 4 within the time specified will result in a nonresponsive bid."

On the original submitted Subcontractor List, Timberworks identified Central Striping as only performing Bid Items 7, 8 and 13-17. However, on the 24-hour submission of the Subcontractor List submitted on March 28, 2013, column 2 was revised to add Bid Items 1 and 3 to the Bid Item numbers. The change in the bid item numbers in column 2 on the 24-hour submission of the Subcontractor List by adding Bid Items 1 and 3 constitutes an improper change to the Subcontractor List form.

Based on the above, Caltrans will proceed to award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder.

Your attention is directed to Section 3-1.04 of the Amendments to the 2010 Standard Specifications. Caltrans is not obligated to offer an extension of the award period for a nonresponsive bid. Should you wish to extend your bid while resolving a nonresponsive finding, you must send your request to the Office Engineer no later than 4:00 p.m., two business days prior to the expiration of your bid.
