BID PROTEST

Gentlemen:

Please consider this letter to be a formal protest of the bids submitted by Golden State Bridge, Inc. (GSB) and Shimmick Construction Company, Inc. (Shimmick), the apparent low bidder and apparent 2nd low bidder, respectively, in connection with Contract No. 02-0E0904. MCM Construction, Inc. is the third low bidder.

Revised Standard Specification Section 2-1.33 BID DOCUMENT COMPLETION AND SUBMITTAL Subsection 2-1.33A states "Failure to submit the forms and *information* as specified may result in a non-responsive bid". (Italics added for emphasis).

Revised Standard Specification Section 2-1.10 SUBCONTRACTOR LIST states in part "For each subcontractor listed, the Subcontractor List must show:

4. Portion of work it will perform. Show the portion of work by:
 - 4.1 Bid item numbers for the subcontracted work
 - 4.2 Percentage of the subcontracted work for each bid item listed
 - 4.3 Description of the subcontracted work if the percentage of the bid item listed is less than 100 percent."

GSB'S SUBCONTRACTOR LIST IS INCOMPLETE AND NON-RESPONSIVE

With regard to GSB's listing of Pacific Coast Drilling Company (PCDC) for Item No.'s 85 and 86, GSB identified the percentage of work for each of the respective items as a percentage less than 100 percent but failed to provide a description of the actual portion of these items of work to be subcontracted.

GSB filed a letter dated November 23, 2015, claiming an inadvertent clerical error regarding GSB's failure to provide a description of work for Item No.'s 85 and 86. Inadvertency is subjective. What is not subjective is the fact that GSB failed to submit the required information with the bid. Caltrans has found this deficiency alone on a Subcontractor List to be cause for finding a bid non-responsive. Reference the attached recent Caltrans letter dated October 8, 2015, whereby Chumo Construction's bid on Contract 07-293404 was found non-responsive because Chumo did not provide a description for a partial listing of bid item 1 valued at only \$3800.

SHIMMICK'S SUBCONTRACTOR LIST IS NON-RESPONSIVE

With regard to Shimmick's listing of Tullis, Inc, ACL Construction Company, Commercial Metals Company (CMC), and Selby's Soil Erosion Control Company, Shimmick listed the following partial items as follows:

Describing the portion of the subcontracted item by merely using the same description as the item description fails to describe the portion of the item subcontracted. They may have just as well not provided any description at all. Consequently, describing the portion of an item with the same description as the item itself, gives Shimmick an unfair competitive advantage on items with a combined value of \$2,348,580 because they can decide post-bid what portions of these items to subcontract.

To further underscore the problem with merely repeating the item description for the portion of the item subcontracted, please reference the listing of bid item 148. Shimmick listed two companies (ACL and CMC) for different percentages of the same item. But, since Shimmick did not adequately describe the portion of the item subcontracted, it is not possible, from the face of the bid, for Caltrans to determine whether ACL and CMC are listed for the same portions of item 148 work.

SHIMMICK'S DBE COMMITMENT SUBMITTAL IS NON-RESPONSIVE

Shimmick's Subcontract List identified K & G Concrete, Inc as the listed subcontractor for bid items 88 thru 90 with a description of "Concrete Pump, Concrete Place, Concrete Furnish".

Revised Standard Specification Section 2-1.12B(2), states "Submit a copy of the quote from each DBE shown on the DBE Commitment form that describes the type and dollar amount of work shown on the form."

Shimmick provided a copy of K & G Concrete's quote which was only for the operated concrete pump and labor to place the concrete. The provided K & G quote did not include any prices for furnishing concrete. Consequently, Shimmick did not comply with Section 2-1.12B(2) and it appears, from Shimmick's submitted K & G quote, that Shimmick expanded the scope of K & G's work on the Subcontractor List beyond that quoted by K & G to Shimmick.

It follows that Shimmick should not be given any DBE credit for the value of furnishing concrete. When that value is deducted from Shimmick's \$1,200,000 commitment to K & G, the remaining value (for pumping and placing) is more on the order of approximately \$70,000. This would make Shimmick's total DBE Commitment approximately \$430,000 or only 1.6% of their total bid. Clearly, a 1.6% DBE Commitment does not reflect a good faith effort.

In addition, the DBE Commitment form instructions state "If 100% of an item is not to be performed or furnished by the DBE describe the exact portion of the item to be performed or furnished". Shimmick listed K & G for less than 100 percent of items 88-90, Structural Concrete, with a description of "Concrete Pump, Concrete Place, Concrete Furnish" but their DBE Commitment form provides a description of K & G's work for items 88-90 as "Structural Concrete". The description "Structural Concrete" is much more broad and not consistent with the bid day listing of K & G.

GSB BID PROTEST SUMMARY

Caltrans must find GSB's bid non-responsive due to their incomplete listing of PCDC. Their listing of PCDC for items 85 and 86 failed to describe the portion of the items to be performed by PCDC as required by Standard Specification Section 2-1.10, subparagraph 4.3. Not providing the requested information can give a bidder an unfair competitive advantage because the bidder can decide post-bid the actual portion of work to be subcontracted. Further, Caltrans has found bids containing a Subcontractor List without a description on a partial item as non-responsive such as recently on Contract 07-293404.

SHIMMICK BID PROTEST SUMMARY

With regard to Shimmick's partial listing of bid items whereby they provide a description of a portion of an item using the exact same description as the item itself, their listing does not, by any means, define the portion of the item subcontracted, as is required by Standard Specification Section 2-1.10. Repeating the item description as the description of the portion of the item subcontracted is worthless information. Surely, Caltrans is not requesting worthless information be provided regarding the portion of an item subcontracted. Repeating the item description as the description of the portion of the item subcontracted gives the bidder an unfair competitive advantage because he is not making any commitment on bid day as to what portion of an item he will subcontract. He thereby has latitude to decide post-bid exactly what portion of the item he will subcontract. Clearly, such a position gives the bidder an unfair advantage over the other bidder who submits a compliant Subcontractor List which commits himself on bid day as to what portion of items he subcontracts.

With regard to Shimmick's DBE Commitment, a quote from K & G Concrete for "Furnish Concrete" was not provided, as required by Section 2-1.12B(2), plus the description of work provided for K & G Concrete is not consistent with the description provided on the Subcontractor List. Shimmick should not be given DBE credit for K & G furnishing concrete which was the bulk of their claimed participation.


Caltrans must find Shimmick's bid non-responsive due to (1) their failure to provide a description of the actual work to be subcontracted, as required by Standard Specification Section 2-1.10, subparagraph 4.3, (2) their unfair competitive advantage gained by not describing the portion of items subcontracted, (3) their failure to provide the DBE quotation for the DBE work on the Subcontractor List, (4) their consequentially meager DBE participation when the value of furnishing concrete is not considered, and (5) the inconsistency between the description of K & G's work on the Subcontractor List and the DBE Commitment form.

The lowest responsive and responsible bidder is MCM Construction, Inc.

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) received a bid submitted by Chumo Construction, Inc. (Chumo) for Contract 07-293404 on September 17, 2015. Caltrans notifies Chumo that its bid is nonresponsive because it failed to properly submit the Subcontractor List form.

2-1.10 Subcontractor List states in part... "For each subcontractor listed, the Subcontractor List form must show: (4.3) Description of the subcontracted work if the percentage of the bid item listed is less than 100 percent."

→ Chumo listed Calstripe to perform 21 percent of bid item 1, but failed to provide the description of subcontracted work.

Based on the above, Caltrans will proceed to award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder provided all requirements are met.

Your attention is directed to Section 3-1.04 of the 2010 Standard Specifications. Caltrans is not obligated to offer an extension of the award period for a nonresponsive bid. Should you wish to extend your bid while resolving a nonresponsive finding, you must send your request to the Office Engineer no later than 4:00 p.m., two business days prior to the expiration of your bid.
