

If paving cannot be completed in this timeframe, additional costs for energy surcharges, increase in material transportation costs or liquid asphalt price escalations, will be added to the final contract price.
- 5) Prices include one move in for paving & grinding. Additional move-ins will result in additional costs due to reduced productivity and added mobilization charges. Unit prices and or mobilization charges will be adjusted accordingly.
- 6) A minimum of 14 days notice with a schedule is required to schedule a move-in, subject to minor adjustments. Project schedule shall be mutually agreeable to DTC and the Owner / Contractor.
- 7) Schedules are subject to extensions caused by unfavorable weather conditions, lack of site accessibility, labor disputes, delay of material deliveries, vandalism, and or acts of God.
