Thank you for the opportunity to provide a proposal for this project. We provide civil engineering and stormwater management services.

Scope of Work:

A. Prepare Water Pollution Control Program (WPCP)

Prepare a Water Pollution Control Program (WPCP). The document will be prepared in accordance with Caltrans requirements. Water Pollution Control Drawings will be included.

Exclusions: Installation and implementation of water pollution practices, providing a WPC Manager, conducting training, and monitoring, inspection and correcting water pollution control practices are excluded. A WPC Manager, training, monitoring and inspection are available as an additional service upon request.

B. Provide Weekly Stormwater Inspection and Water Pollution Control Manager, for weekly inspection

- I. Provide Water Pollution Control Manager (WPC Manager) with appropriate Qualified SWPPP Practitioner (QSP) certification.
- II. Provide inspection 1 day per week of stormwater Best Management Practices (BMP's) and oversee BMP implementation; inspections will be done or overseen by a QSP.
- III. Provide quarterly non-stormwater monitoring inspection.
- IV. Check NOAA weather forecast daily.
- V. Provide stormwater inspection reports once a week.
- VI. Prepare WPCP Amendments as needed.
- VII. Provide initial SWPPP training to contractor's staff and subcontractors at beginning of job.
- VIII. Exclusions; Does not include any onsite sampling or lab testing if there is an event that triggers non-stormwater, non-visible pollutant or other testing. Assumes contractor's staff can provide the daily, pre-storm, during storm and post-storm visual BMP rain event inspection to reduce costs unless otherwise contracted for (See Item C below for rain event inspection).

C. Provide Stormwater Inspector for Pre-Storm, During Storm or Post Storm Inspection

- I. Provide Pre-storm inspection; before a forecasted storm event which is defined as one with a 50% chance or more of occurrence.
- II. Provide During storm inspection. This is required every 24 hours during extended storm events. A storm event is defined as one that produces or is forecasted to produce at least 0.10 inch of rain within a 24 hour period (per Caltrans definition).
- III. Provide Post storm inspection; after a qualifying rain event. A qualifying rain event is one that produces 1/2" or more of rain with a 48 hour or greater period between rain events.
- IV. Inspections will be done or overseen by a QSP.

The WPCP will be prepared for a Fixed Fee of the following, with fees billed monthly based upon percent completion:
