

Teichert hereby requests relief from its bid proposal for subject project due to mistake in the bid. During the electronic submittal process, Teichert experienced computer connectivity problems that prevented electronic submission of our final bid proposal as intended. The bid information that was uploaded was incomplete and incorrect, as it was from a preliminary electronic submittal made earlier on bid day. The intended final bid proposal information was not transmitted prior to bid close due to electronic submittal problems that delayed the transmittal from Expedite software program. The total contract value and subcontractor listings that CalTrans received were not intended to be final and materially differ by substantial dollar amount.


