Dear Mr. Cianciarulo:

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) received the attached letter dated May 6, 2014, from Granite Rock Company (Granite Rock) protesting the bid submitted by Bay Cities Paving & Grading, Inc. (Bay Cities). The protest alleges that Bay Cities impermissibly expanded the scope of work for ABSL when it listed Bid Item 51 (Roadway Excavation) to work initially listed as AC Grinding. In addition, included Bid Item 145 (Mobilization) to work subcontracted to Flatiron Electric, Central Striping and Drill Tech Drilling. Granite Rock is requesting that Caltrans find the bid submitted by Bay Cities nonresponsive and the award the contract to Granite Rock.

Caltrans reviewed the bid documents as well as this protest and finds that Bay Cities properly followed the bidding instructions on bid date by identifying the subcontractor and the description of work for AC Grinding. On the 24 hour submittal Bay Cities provided the same information and the corresponding bid item numbers to that description of work. It is the opinion of Caltrans that by including 2% of bid item 51, Roadway Excavation on the 24 hour submittal, Bay Cities did not expand the scope of work set forth for ABSL in the bid day submission of the Subcontractor list as AC Grinding is a component of the Roadway Excavation on this Project.


With respect to the protest as it relates to Flatiron, Central Striping and Drill Tech Drilling, Mobilization is relative to the scope of work being performed by these subcontractors as they must first mobilize onto the Project site in order to complete their work, and mobilization, by itself, is not considered work requiring a contractor's license.

Based on the above, Caltrans finds that Granite Rock's protest lacks merit and will award the contract to the lowest responsive bidder.

Subject: *Protest of Bay Cities Paving & Grading Inc. Bid*

Dear Mr. McMillan,

Granite Rock Company ("Graniterock") submitted the second-lowest bid on the Project. Bay Cities Paving & Grading Inc. ("Bay Cities") submitted the apparent low bid on the Project. Granite Rock hereby protests Bay Cities' bid as nonresponsive for violating the Subletting and Subcontracting Fair Practices Act. The bid of Bay Cities must be deemed nonresponsive and the contract should be awarded to Graniterock as the lowest-responsible bidder.

Bay Cities Bid Impermissibly Expanded the Scope of Work of Four Different Subcontractors: ABSL Construction, Flatiron Electric Group, Central Striping, and Drill Tech Drilling

On bid day, Bay Cities submitted the Subcontractor List attached as Exhibit 1, which included completed information only for Columns 1 and 4. Within 24 hours of bid time, Bay Cities submitted the 24-Hour List attached as Exhibit 2, which added information for Columns 2 and 3.

Impermissible Expansion of ABSL Construction's Scope. On the Subcontractor List, Bay Cities listed ABSL Construction ("ABSL") for *one* item, AC Grinding. The Project Bid Item List listed "Cold Plane Asphalt Concrete Pavement" as Item 46. Then, on its 24-Hour List, Bay Cities listed ABSL for *two* items:

Item No. 46 Cold Plane Asphalt Concrete Pavement, and
 Item No. 51 Roadway Excavation

Bay Cities' inclusion of a second item of work for ABSL on the 24-Hour List (Roadway Excavation, Item 51) impermissibly expanded ABSL's scope of work beyond the scope identified on the Subcontractor Listing (only AC Grinding).

Impermissible Expansion of Flatiron Electric Group's Scope. On the Subcontractor List, Bay Cities listed Flatiron Electric Group ("Flatiron") for *three* items, Temp Traffic Signals, Maintain Exist Traffic Mgmt. System and Modify Variable Message Sign. The Project Bid Item List listed "Temporary Signal Systems" as Items 10-13, "Maintain Existing Traffic Management" as Item 123, and "Modify Variable Message Sign" as Item 124. Then, on its 24-Hour List, Bay Cities listed Flatiron for the following *four* items:

Item No. 10-13 Temporary Signal System,
 Item No. 123 Maintain Existing Traffic Management,
 Item No. 124 Modify Variable Message Sign, and
 Item No. 145 Mobilization

Bay Cities' inclusion of a fourth item of work for Flatiron on the 24-Hour List (Mobilization, Item 145) impermissibly expanded Flatiron's scope of work beyond the scope identified on the Subcontractor Listing (only Temporary Signal System, Maintain Existing Traffic Management and Modify Variable Message Sign).

Impermissible Expansion of Central Striping's Scope. On the Subcontractor List, Bay Cities listed Central Striping ("Central") for Striping & Markers & Related. The Project Bid Item List listed "Temporary Pavement Marking" as Item 6, "Remove Yellow Thermoplastic Traffic Stripe" as Item 34, "Remove Thermoplastic Traffic Stripe" as Item #37, "Remove Pavement Marker as Item 38, "Thermoplastic Stripes and Markings as Items #117 - 120 and 122, "Temporary Traffic Stripe" as Item 126, "Remove Painted Stripes and Markings" as Item 129 and 130. Then, on its 24-Hour List, Bay Cities listed Central for all of the following items:

Item No. 6 Temporary Pavement Marking,
 Item No. 34 Remove Yellow Thermoplastic Stripe,
 Item No. 37 Remove Thermoplastic Traffic Stripe,
 Item No. 38 Remove Pavement Marker,

Bay Cities' inclusion of an entirely new item of work for Central on the 24-Hour List (Mobilization, Item 145) impermissibly expanded Central's scope of work beyond the scope identified on the Subcontractor Listing (only Striping and Markers and Related).

Impermissible Expansion of Drill Tech Drilling's Scope. On the Subcontractor List, Bay Cities listed Drill Tech Drilling ("Drilltech") for Soil Nail, Structural & Sculpted Shot Crete, and Prepare & Stain Shot Crete. The Projects Bid Item List listed "Soil Nail" as Item 73, "Structural Shot Crete" as Item 77, "Sculpted Shot Crete" as Item 78, "Prepare and Stain Sculpted Shot Crete" as Item 85. Then, on its 24-Hour List, Bay Cities listed Drilltech for all of the following items:

Item No. 73	Soil Nail
Item No. 77	Structural Shot Crete
Item No. 78	Sculpted Shot Crete
Item No. 85	Prepare and Stain Sculpted Shot Crete
<i>Item No. 145</i>	<i>Mobilization</i>

Bay Cities' inclusion of an entirely new item of work for Drilltech on the 24-Hour List (Mobilization, Item 145) impermissibly expanded Central's scope of work beyond the scope identified on the Subcontractor Listing (only Soil Nail, Structural & Sculpted Shot Crete, Prepare & Stain Shot Crete).

The Department requires that bidders accurately describe the work which their subcontractors are to perform in Column 4 on bid day. The Department has consistently held that a bidder will not be allowed to expand a subcontractor's listed scope of work after the bid opening.

For instance, the Department found that Graniterock/Pavex Construction's bid as nonresponsive for Contract 04-4G1004 because Pavex described a subcontractor's work as Construction Area Signs yet included Roadside Signs listed for the subcontractor. See the Department's letter to Graniterock/Pavex Construction dated November 2, 2012, including the attached subcontractor list and 24-hour list, attached as Exhibit 3. The Department determined that Construction Area Signs and Roadside Signs are two different categories of work. Caltrans stated in its decision "Since Farwest was originally subcontracted to perform Construction Area Signs, but roadway signs were added to the revised bid list received on October 1, 2012, Caltrans finds your bid is nonresponsive."



It is also worth noting that, over the past two years, Bay Cities has protested multiple apparently low bids with the Department for deficiencies substantially identical to the deficiencies in Bay Cities' bid on this Project. (See, for example, Bay Cities' protest of Contract 04-153204.)

In conclusion, for the reasons outlined above, the bid submitted by Bay Cities on this Project is nonresponsive and must, in accordance with applicable law and the Department's consistent practice, be rejected. Accordingly, the contract should be awarded to Granite Rock Company as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

Pavex Construction Division (Pavex Construction) submitted a bid for contract 04-4G1004 on September 28, 2012. By this letter, the Department of Transportation (Caltrans) notifies Pavex Construction that its bid is nonresponsive because it failed to properly submit the Subcontractor List.

The Subcontractor List form states in part, "...Complete columns 1 and 4 and submit with the bid. Complete columns 2 and 3 and submit with the bid or fax to (916) 227-6282 within 24 hours after the bid opening. Failure to provide complete information in columns 1 through 4 within the time specified will result in a nonresponsive bid." No other revisions to the form are permitted.

Since Farwest was originally subcontracted to perform Construction Area Signs, but roadway signs were added to the revised bid list received on October 1, 2012, Caltrans finds your bid is nonresponsive. Caltrans will proceed to award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder provided all requirements are met.

Your attention is directed to Section 3-1.02 of the Amendments to the 2006 Standard Specifications. Caltrans is not obligated to offer an extension of the award period for a nonresponsive bid. Should you wish to offer to extend your bid while resolving a nonresponsive finding you must send your request to the Office Engineer no later than 4:00 pm two business days prior to the expiration of your bid.


