The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) received a bid from J.J. Nguyen, Inc. (J.J. Nguyen) for contract 04-2G3614 on April 9, 2013. By way of this letter, Caltrans notifies J.J. Nguyen that its bid is nonresponsive because it failed to properly submit the Subcontractor List.

The Subcontractor List form states in part, "...Complete columns 1 and 4 and submit with the bid. Complete columns 2 and 3 and submit with the bid or fax to (916) 227-6282 within 24 hours after the bid opening. Failure to provide complete information in columns 1 through 4 within the time specified will result in a nonresponsive bid." J.J. Nguyen failed to submit the percent of bid item 6, as required in column 3.

Based on the above action, Caltrans will proceed to award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder provided that all requirements are met.

Your attention is directed to Section 3-1.04 of the 2010 Standard Specifications. Caltrans is not obligated to offer an extension of the award period for a nonresponsive bid. Should you wish to extend your bid while resolving a nonresponsive finding, you must send your request to the Office Engineer no later than 4:00 pm, two business days prior to the expiration of your bid.

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) received a letter from Northwest Paving (Northwest) protesting a bid submitted by Shasta Service, Inc. dba (Timberworks) for Contract No. 02-4F1604 on March 27, 2013. The protest alleges that Timberworks made material changes to the Subcontractors List after bid opening. Northwest requests that Caltrans find the bid submitted by Timberworks nonresponsive and award the contract to the next responsible bidder.

Caltrans did not complete an evaluation of this protest since the bid submitted by Timberworks was found nonresponsive.

Based on the above, Caltrans finds Northwest's protest has no bearing on the awarding of this contract. Caltrans will proceed to award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder provided that all requirements are met.
