Dear Mr. McMillan:

Please accept this letter is an Amendment to our May 22, 2014 bid protest letter. We would like to bring to Caltrans' attention a previous bidding issue that is similar to the issue we raised in our May 22, 2014 bid protest in which that bidder was determined to be nonresponsive.

Caltrans determined the bid submitted by Mercer-Fraser Company (MFC) for Contract No. 02-2E5104 to be nonresponsive because MFC listed Apply-A-Line to perform Striping work on bid day but Pavement Marker was added to the revised bid list in their 24 hour submittal. Caltrans determined that Pavement Marker work is not Striping work.

In this case of Contract No. 04-2G6004, Ghilotti Construction Company (GCC) listed Chrisp Company on bid day to perform Striping and Marking work but Pavement Marker was added to the revised bid list in their 24 hour submittal. The "Striping and Marking" scope of work written by GCC is the same as the "Striping" scope of work written by MFC so GCC has added Pavement Marker work in their revised bid list just as MFC did.

The bid submitted by GCC should be considered nonresponsive, just as the bid submitted by MFC was determined to be nonresponsive by Caltrans. We request that project be awarded to our firm as the lowest responsive bidder.
