

INCLUSIONS

- Furnish deformed reinforcing bars detailed per CRSI standards, FOB job site for concrete, drill and grouted dowels (placing of reinforcing by others)
- Furnish, fabricate and build on job site; cages for CIDH piles, cages stockpiled FOB (blocking and setting cages by others)
- Reinforcing bar furnished for minor concrete (minor structure) FOB job site
- Reinforcing for all Type 60 barrier rails is to be furnished FOB job site

EXCLUSIONS

- Hoisting or lowering of reinforcing materials including unloading trucks, setting cages or assemblies and power placing bar bundles
- Reinforcing shown in civil, landscape, mechanical, electrical and plumbing drawings


