Dear Mr. McMillan:

The current apparent low bidder on the project is Certified Coatings Company (CCC). F.D. Thomas, Inc. (F.D. Thomas) is the apparent second-low bidder. F.D. Thomas protests the award of the contract to CCC on the grounds that CCC's bid is non-responsive due to CCC's failure to comply with the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise requirements. Please refer to the detail associated with this protest of CCC's bid.

Certified Coatings Company Failed To Comply With Requirements of Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Goal

The Standard Specifications 2010 and Special Provisions for this project require multiple DBE goals. The "Notice to Bidders" lists the requirements for DBE goals. CCC has failed to meet the requirements for the following reasons:

- CCC has not met the goal for the project, while other bidders have. Their listing is for 1.03%, is only half of the reasonable goal for this project. CCC has failed to meet the goal.
- While Certified did advertise for different bid items for DBE goals, CCC did not necessarily a "Good Faith Effort". CCC did not meet the goal AND CCC did not provide quotations for their advertised items of work yet chose not to use these quotations.
 - A specific example of this is requesting quote for "MESSAGE SIGNS (LS)" many multiple times. CCC did not request very competitive quotations from DBE Contractors. CCC listed CMC and YCAT-C, which are shown in the Contract. CCC listed no contractor for this work in their bid and they did not perform. We believe there was no intention to award this item and CCC advertised with no intention to award to DBE sub-contractors as other Prime Bidders for this contract. CCC should be considered a "Good Faith Effort".

Dear Mr. McMillan:

The current apparent low bidder on the project is Certified Coatings Company (CCC). F.D. Thomas, Inc. (F.D. Thomas) is the apparent second-low bidder. F.D. Thomas hereby protests the award of the contract to CCC on the grounds that CCC's bid is non-responsive since, CCC failed to comply with the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise requirements. Please see the following detail associated with this protest of CCC's bid.

Certified Coatings Company Failed To Comply With Requirements of 2-1.12B Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Goal

The Standard Specifications 2010 and Special Provisions for this project contain multiple requirements for DBE goals. The "Notice to Bidders" lists the DBE goal at 2% for this project. CCC has failed to meet the requirements for the following reasons:

- CCC has not met the goal for the project, while other bidders were able to meet the goal. Their listing is for 1.03%, is only half of the reasonable goal of 2%.
- While Certified did advertise for different bid items for the project this is not necessarily a "Good Faith Effort". CCC did not meet the goal AND did receive quotations for their advertised items of work yet chose not to use these quotations.
 - A specific example of this is requesting quotes for "PORTABLE CHANGEABLE MESSAGE SIGNS (LS)" many multiple times and then receiving at least five different very competitive quotations from DBE Contractors (Manerri, Flash Traffic, KRC Safety, CMC and YCAT-C, which are shown in the CCC DBE submittal). CCC listed no contractor for this work in their bid and they listed this Bid Item 6 for \$1.00 and self-performed. We believe there was no intention to use any quotation from any DBE for this item and CCC advertised with no intention of using the qualified DBE sub-contractors as other Prime Bidders for this contract did. This cannot be considered a "Good Faith Effort".



- CCC Failed to list the specific detail that shows what work DBE Hernandez Engineering is providing for Bid Item 5. Certified lists them for \$39,780.00 but this does not match the quotation from the sub-contractor. There are no specifics as to what is being supplied. According to the U.S. Government Publishing Office website link from the Cal Trans Website⁽¹⁾, Title 49, Subtitle A → Part 26, Subpart C, section §26.55 states that *"When a DBE participates in a contract, you count only the value of the work actually performed by the DBE toward DBE goals"*.
 - By not specifically showing the work that will be performed that equals the listed amount in the DBE forms and the sub-contractor listing form then Certified has not met the requirement listed in note 2 of the DBE Form Instructions which state:
 - *"If 100% of an item is not performed or furnished by the DBE, describe the exact portion of the item to be performed or furnished"*.
 - CCC failed to describe what portion or in what capacity that Hernandez Engineering will work for Bid Item 5 and the quotation does not match the listed amount.

Conclusion

Since Certified Coatings Company's bid clearly does not meet the DBE requirements while other Contractors did so, F.D. Thomas respectfully requests that Caltrans reject Certified Coatings Company's bid, and award the contract to F.D. Thomas as the lowest responsible, responsive bidder.


