Dear Mr. Papich:

Papich Construction Company (Papich Construction), submitted a bid for contract 05-0G1604 on February 12, 2013. The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) notifies Papich Construction that its bid has been found nonresponsive because the bidder's bond was not notarized and signed by the surety insurance company at the time of bid opening.

Standard Specifications section 2-1.34 BIDDER'S SECURITY states in part:

"Submit your bid with one of the following forms of bidder's security...Bidder's bond signed by a surety insurer who is licensed in California."

Based on the above, Caltrans will proceed to award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder provided all requirements are met.

Your attention is directed to Section 3-1.04 of the 2010 Standard Specifications. Caltrans is not obligated to offer an extension of the award period for a nonresponsive bid. Should you wish to extend your bid while resolving a nonresponsive finding, you must send your request to the Office Engineer no later than 4:00 pm, two business days prior to the expiration of your bid.
