For a cost plus time based bid on a contract without a plant establishment period, Bidder additionally agrees to perform the work within the number of working days bid.

For a cost plus time based bid on a contract with a plant establishment period, Bidder additionally agrees to perform the non-plant establishment work within the number of working days bid for non-plant establishment work.

2. For a lump sum based bid, Bidder submits this bid with a total price in the total bid space provided on the Bid Item List. For a unit price or cost plus time based bid, Bidder submits this bid with a unit price and the item total (the product of the unit price and the quantity) for each item and a total price (the sum of the item totals) in the spaces provided on the attached Bid Item List. For a unit price with additive item based bid, Bidder submits this bid with a unit price and an item total for each item and a total base bid (the sum of the item totals) and the additive items in the spaces provided on the attached Bid Item List. 2.1. If a discrepancy between the unit price and the item total exists, the unit price prevails except:

2.1.2. If a decimal error is apparent in the product of the unit price and the quantity, the Department will use either the unit price or item total based on the closest by percentage to the unit price or item total in the Department's Final Estimate.

2.2. If the unit price and the item total are illegible or are omitted, the bid may be determined nonresponsive. If a lump sum total price is illegible or is omitted, the bid may be determined nonresponsive.

2.3. Bids on lump sum items are item totals. If a unit price for a lump sum item is entered and it differs from the item total, the item total prevails.

2.4. Entries are to be expressed in dollars or decimal fractions of a dollar. Symbols such as commas and dollar signs are ignored and have no significance in establishing unit price or item total.

2.5. Unit prices and item totals are interpreted by the number of digits and decimal placement. Do not round item totals or the total bid.

- 2.6. For a lump sum based bid, the item total is the bid amount the Department uses for bid comparison.
For a unit price based bid, the sum of the item totals is the bid amount the Department uses for bid comparison.
For a cost plus time based bid, the sum of the item totals and the total bid for time is the bid amount the Department uses for bid comparison.
- 2.7. The Department's decision on the bid amount is final.

Dear Contractor:

This addendum is being issued to the contract for CONSTRUCTION ON STATE HIGHWAY IN SANTA CRUZ COUNTY AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS FROM 0.9 MILE NORTH OF LAGUNA ROAD TO WADDELL CREEK BRIDGE.

Submit bids for this work with the understanding and full consideration of this addendum. The revisions declared in this addendum are an essential part of the contract.

Bids for this work will be opened on Wednesday, February 13, 2013.

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.02 "ORDER OF WORK," the third paragraph is revised as follows:

"Attention is directed to "NONHIGHWAY FACILITIES (INCLUDING UTILITIES)" of these special provisions regarding underground utilities.

The work to install guardrail within railroad right of way at PM 29.04 to 29.07 shall not begin before July 15, 2013. However, the Contractor can request an earlier start by submitting a written request to the Engineer and upon the approval of the Engineer."

In the Special Provisions, Section 4 "BEGINNING OF WORK, TIME OF COMPLETION AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES," is revised as follows:

"The 1st working day is the earlier of (1) the 35th day after contract approval or (2) the day you start work other than the measurement of controlling field dimensions or the location of utilities.

Do not start work at the job site until the Engineer approves your submittal for:
Water Pollution Control Program (WPCP)

You may enter the job site only to measure controlling field dimensions and locating utilities. Do not start other work activities until all the submittals from the above list are approved and the following information is submitted:

1. Notice of Materials To Be Used.
2. Contingency plan for reopening closures to public traffic.

You may start work at the job site before the 35th day after contract approval if:

1. You obtain required approval for each submittal before the 35th day
2. The Engineer authorizes it in writing
