Dear Mr. Souza:

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) received the attached letter dated February 5, 2014 from Souza Construction, Inc. (Souza), protesting the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Commitment Form submitted by both Rockwood General Contractors, Inc. (Rockwood) and America Pacific Construction (America) on the above referenced contract. The protest alleges that Rockwood failed to demonstrate that they achieved the 6 percent DBE participation goal for this contract. In addition, America submitted its DBE commitment documents claiming \$100,636.64 or 50.4 percent participation. As such, America failed to make work available to DBEs. Souza requests that Caltrans reject both bids and award the contract to Souza.

Caltrans did not conduct a review of this protest as it pertains to Rockwood, since Rockwood did not make a Good Faith Effort to meet the goal.


As the protest relates to America, the Office of Business and Economic Opportunity, Contract Evaluation Branch (CEB) conducted an evaluation of the DBE documents submitted by America, and determined that America did meet the goal of this contract.

Therefore, Caltrans will proceed to award this contract to America, provided that all requirements have been met.

**RE: Caltrans Contract No: 05-1A0904; Bid Protest re: American Pacific Construction, Rockwood General Contractor's Inc.**

Souza Construction, Inc. ("Souza") hereby submits this protest of the bids that both American Pacific Construction ("American Pacific") and Rockwood General Contractor's, Inc ("Rockwood") for Caltrans Project 05-1A0904 ("project") on the basis that both American Pacific and Rockwood failed to demonstrate that they achieved the DBE participation goal set for this project and is thus nonresponsive to the solicitation.

Caltrans Standard Specifications (2010), Section 2 (Bidding), 2.1.12, DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISES, addresses DBE enterprises in the context of bidding CalTrans Projects. Section 2-1.12B (1) paragraph 1 states that "Section 2-1.12B applies if a DBE goal is shown on the Notice to Bidders". Please find attached "Exhibit A" Notice to Bidders. The Notice to Bidders states that "The DBE Contract goal is 6 percent". Thus, per the requirements of §2-1.12, bidders on the project at issue must meet the stated DBE participation goal of six percent (6%). Furthermore, bidders must demonstrate such compliance through utilization of the CalTrans Bidder-DBE-Commitment Form (Des-OE-0102.10C).


American Pacific Construction submitted their DBE commitment (see exhibit "B") and demonstrated \$100,636.64 or (50.4%) total claimed participation. Please note that the submitted commitment includes zero (0) DBE subcontractor or supplier participation, and attempts to meet the DBE goal by participating as a General Contractor. Section 2-1.12B (1) general, paragraph 4, states the following: "Make work available to DBEs and select work parts consistent with available DBE subcontractors and suppliers." As a result, the DBE Participation secured by American Pacific on the project falls under 6% and does not meet the explicitly stated contract goal.

Rockwood submitted the DBE commitment (see exhibit "C") and provided 0% total claimed participation. As a result, the DBE participation secured by Rockwood on the project falls under 6% and does not meet the explicitly stated contract goal.

Please find the CalTrans Bidder -DBE-Commitment submitted by Souza (see exhibit "D"). Please note that our total claimed participation of \$12,876.80, or 6.39%, exceeds the DBE Goal of 6% and meets the project requirements in all respects. Souza went to great measure during the bidding process to solicit participation from a pipe supplier that was unaware of the project. We extensively searched for participants certified for the appropriate CUF so that we could meet the requirements of the contract. Please note that Maskell Pipe is certified for furnishing the 48" RCP pipe. In addition, Souza obtained a subcontract bid from KRC to furnish and install construction area signs even though Souza owns the signs and could have installed them at considerable savings. We recognize the importance of achieving the Contract Goal, and would continue to find additional ways to meet the goals until they were met.

As the above discussion demonstrates, both American Pacific Construction, and Rockwood, have failed to meet the clearly stated requirements for DBE participation on the project. As such, both bids are nonresponsive. See, Taylor Bus Service, Inc. v. San Diego Bd. Of Education, 195 Cal.App.3d 1331,1341 (1987) ("A bid is responsive if it promises to do what the bidding instructions demand"). It is elementary in the present situation that any bidder allowed to evade the DBE participation goal, a requirement provided by law, secures unto themselves an undeniable competitive advantage over other bidders. As such, these deviations from the project specifications in both bids cannot be deemed inconsequential, and their bids must be rejected as nonresponsive.
