





Pre-storm, during storm, and post-storm inspection. QSP shall observe site during extended rain event. Photographs will be taken during all inspections and included in all applicable reports.

ITEM 6: PREPARE SWPPP:

Consultant shall prepare project Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP). The SWPPP shall be prepared, signed, and stamped by a Caltrans certified Qualified SWPPP Developer (QSD).

If project is a Risk Level 2:

ITEM 7: REAP:

Rain Event Action Plan work to include:

Preparing and submitting REAP forms and monitoring weather forecasts. The WPC Manager will submit a REAP to protect the jobsite at least 48 hours before predicted rain event. Prepare a REAP when the National Weather Service is predicting at least a 50% probability of precipitation within 72 hours. The REAP shall use approved forms and include:

- Site location, risk level, contact information including 24 hour emergency phone numbers.
- Storm Information
- Construction phase information

A REAP will be issued to the WPC Manager 48 hours before predicted rain event in order to satisfy the requirement of having the REAP on site 24 hours before the predicted rain event. Please see scope in Storm Water Sampling and Analysis Day for during event inspections. Pre and post inspections- see item CSM, option 2.

Consultant shall provide a Cal Trans Certified QSP to perform water sampling and provide inspection for WPC practices identified in the SWPPP.

Includes preparation, collection, analysis, and reporting of storm water samples for turbidity, pH, and other constituents specified in the SWPPP. When there is a qualified rain event that produces runoff, comply with the project's SAP for preparation, collection analysis, and reporting of storm water samples. Samples will be collected during first 2 hours of qualified rain event that produces runoff, and normal working hours.

ITEM 9: STORM WATER ANNUAL REPORT

Preparation to include: certifications, monitoring and inspection results, obtaining Storm Water Annual Report Acceptance.

Storm water monitoring information including:

- Summary and evaluation of sampling and analysis results including laboratory reports.
- Analytical methods, reporting units, detection limits for analytical parameters.
- Summary of corrective actions
- Identification of corrective actions or compliance activities that were not implemented.
- Summary of violations
- Names of individuals performing storm water inspections and sampling
- Logistical information for inspections and sampling including location, date, time, and precipitation.
- Visual observations and sample collection records.

- Safety Striping Service, Inc is signatory to the Laborer's of Northern and Southern California.
- Safety Striping Service, Inc is a certified California DVBE (Certification # 14354).
- Safety Striping Service, Inc. requires IMMEDIATE notification upon being listed by the apparent low bidder, for purposes of scheduling and material management.
- Safety Striping Service, Inc. requires a written subcontract, purchase order or signed quote prior to mobilization for any work, or placing the order for job specific materials (i.e. signs, lead plans, etc).
- Safety Striping Service, Inc requires an invitation to pre-job meetings.
- Bonds are not included in this quote. If bonds are required, call for rate.
- This quote includes one (1) move-in, defined as a period of consecutive eight hour days of continuous work, not including weekends or holidays. Any deviances from this, other than those initiated by Safety Striping Service, Inc, will be considered additional move-ins and billed at \$3,500.00 each.
- Referencing is included in this quote. Our referencing is LINEAR ONLY, identifying the limits of and changes in the striping details present prior to obliteration. Contractor is required to comply with Section 39-6.01 of the 2006 Standard Specifications (39-1.11 of the 2010 S.S.). Field Layout due to the misplacement of paving seams is at the prime Contractor's expense (Extra Work Force Account). Mobilization for referencing will not be considered a move-in.
- There is no striping / marking / marker removal included in this quote.
- Bid excludes any and all items related to handling hazardous materials including, but not limited to: *removal, testing, containment, hauling and disposal*. If potentially hazardous material (i.e. yellow thermoplastic) is discovered on the job-site, we will stop work until it is determined (in writing) to be non-hazardous, or a change order is issued for proper handling.
- This quote includes removal of tabs placed on center and lane lines only (excludes any locations where delineators can be used). This applies only to tabs properly placed at approximately 24' on center. *All tab maintenance is the responsibility of the contractor.*
- Message Boards are not included in this quote.

- The bid includes traffic control for our work. We require exclusive access to the roadway without obstacles and the ability to begin work upon arrival at the job-site. Delays caused by conflicts in scheduling are the responsibility of the Contractor and are subject to standby time computed as labor in section 9-1.03A of the Standard Specifications.
- This quotation is valid for a period of sixty (60) calendar days from the date of issue and may be extended at the sole discretion of Safety Striping Service, Inc.




