- 10 Lump Sum price for Construction Area Signs includes: **USA Notification**, installation, removal and **INITIAL** dating of any ramp signs. Contractor will be responsible for maintenance, changing dates on signs as required and removal of USA markings. All construction area signs are considered rental and shall remain property of KRC SAFETY CO., INC. at the conclusion of project.
- 11 Per KRC standard rental agreement prime contractor will be charged replacement cost for any signs, lumber or barricades missing and or damaged at conclusion of project. This amount must be paid in full within 30 days by the contractor, retention shall not be held on this amount.
- 12 Prior to KRC SAFETY CO., INC. installing any signs contractor must have proper agency (i.e. Caltrans, County, City, etc.) mark out all sign locations. Agency must also mark out their underground utilities and or pipes that are not located by USA. Therefore KRC SAFETY CO., INC. will not be responsible for any damage done to agencies utilities that have not been correctly marked out.
- 13 Bid item 2 includes (2) mobilizations. Additional mobilizations will be charged at \$500.00 each.
- 14 KRC SAFETY CO., INC. will not provide performance or payment bonds to the contractor.
- 15 Retention shall not be held on any work performed by KRC.

- 20 KRC SAFETY will submit only the documentation that is required by the project specifications of subcontractor. No other documents shall be required as a conditions of payment by the prime contractor.


