The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) received a bid submitted by Myers and Sons Construction, LP, (Myers and Sons) for Contract No. 06-432604 on November 6, 2014. By this letter, Caltrans notifies Myers and Sons that it must self perform any item listed on the Subcontractor List where the percentage of work exceeds 100 percent.

On the Subcontractor List form Myers and Sons identified Papich Construction Company and W.C. Maloney, as performing 100 percent of bid items 30, 31,32 (Remove Down drain, Adjust Utility Cover to Grade and Cold Plane Asphalt Concrete Pavement). In addition, also identified Safety Striping Service and W.C. Maloney as performing 100 percent of the bid items 28 and 29 (Remove Thermoplastic Traffic Strip, Remove Pavement Marker).

Public Contract Code Section 4106 states in part, *"...If a prime contractor fails to specify a subcontractor or if a prime contractor specifies more than one subcontractor for the same portion of work to be performed under the same contract in excess of one-half of 1 percent of the prime contractor's bid, the prime contractor agrees that he or she is fully qualified to perform that portion of work himself or herself, and that the prime contractor shall perform that portion himself or herself."*

Based on the above, Caltrans will proceed to award this contract to lowest responsive bidder, provided all requirements have been met.
