Dear Mr. King:

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) received a bid submitted by PK Construction (PKC) for Contract 07-1W3204 on September 19, 2013. By this letter, Caltrans notifies PKC that its bid is nonresponsive because PKC failed to properly complete the Subcontractor List form.

The Subcontractor List form states in part, "*...Complete columns 1 and 4 and submit with the bid. Complete columns 2 and 3 and submit with the bid or fax to (916) 227-6282 within 24 hours after the bid opening. Failure to provide complete information in columns 1 through 4 within the time specified will result in a nonresponsive bid.*"

On the Subcontractor List form submitted on September 19, 2013, PKC listed Pacific Electric, Chrisp Company and Maneri Traffic in column 1 of the Subcontractor's List form. However, PKC failed to complete column 3, the percentage of bid item(s) subcontracted. In addition, WEI Industries was listed to perform work described as electrical and safety equipment signs, with percentages listed as; "to equal 5 % set" and "portion not less than 5%." Caltrans requires a bidder to submit the exact percentage of all work being performed. Unfortunately, Caltrans could not determine the actual amount and/or percentage of work to be performed.

Based on the above, Caltrans will proceed to award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder provided all requirements are met.

Your attention is directed to Section 3-1.04 of the 2010 Standard Specifications. Caltrans is not obligated to offer an extension of the award period for a nonresponsive bid. Should you wish to extend your bid while resolving a nonresponsive finding, you must send your request to the Office Engineer no later than 4:00 p.m., two business days prior to the expiration of your bid.
