2.) Activities of Disposal Facilities: Global Transloading, LLC shall assist in gaining waste acceptance at the designated landfill facilities. It is the responsibility of the GENERATOR to provide all necessary analytical documentation and any other necessary documentation to facilitate this process. The Landfill Facility is a highly regulated facility that may require explanations as to how waste characterization has been performed prior to issuing waste acceptance. Please allow for five (5) days prior to commencement of disposal activities for the profiling process to be complete. Any delays associated with the profiling process and gaining waste acceptance outside the control of Global Transloading (i.e, the delay of GENERATOR to provide necessary information) shall not be the responsibility of Global Transloading.
