

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) received the attached letter dated June 20, 2013, from T. W. Contracting, Inc. (TW), protesting the bid submitted by MGP Construction (MGP) for contract 08-OR8604. The protest alleges that MGP does not hold the appropriate license classification. TW requests that Caltrans find MGP nonresponsive and award the contract to TW.
