



- 3. Contractor to wire 110VAC power into mains panel of new RWS200 electronics and install external breaker box local to tower prior to Supplier commissioning trip.**
- 4. Cables & brackets listed are for a tower mounted RPU enclosure with atmospheric sensors mounted on same tower. If RPU enclosure is not mounted on tower, additional cable charges will apply.**

- 12. All equipment will be covered by a two-year Supplier standard factory warranty (not an on-site warranty) from the date of commissioning.**
