
Roadway Engineering Works, Inc. respectfully wishes to add the following additional points of protest the apparent low bid turned in by Amland Corp. The apparent low bidder has unbalanced their bid in respects to bid item number 25 (Maintain Existing Traffic Management System Elements during Construction). The points item by item are noted below;

Bid Item 25 (Maintain "ETMSE" During Construction), Amland Corp's bid for this item is \$25,000.00. Roadway Engineering Works, Inc. bid for this same item is \$1,000.00. The average lump sum bid for B/I 25 based on bidders 2-6 is \$2,784.00. Amland Corp's bid for bid item 25 is \$22,216.00 higher than the average combined bidders 2-6. As a matter of fact Caltrans could take and combine all the total cost of B/I 25 from bidders 2-6 and will only come up with a combined total value of \$13,920.00. Again this is just another example of Amland Corp front loading bid item's to protect monies that belonged to the Building bid item.

Also please note that Amland Corp has certified on page 16 of the bid doc's under "EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY REGULATION CERTIFICATION" that Amland Corp "HAS NOT" participated in a previous contract or subcontract subject to the equal opportunity clauses, as required by executive orders 10925, 11114, or 11246. I would recommend that Caltrans Investigate Amland Corp certifying that they have not.
