





- 6) Attorney fees and interest: If court action be instituted on this invoice, general contractor promises to pay reasonable attorney fees. A late payment charge of 1 1/2% per month will be charged on all invoices not paid within terms of quote. This is annual percentage rate of 18 %.
- 7) **General Contractor to provide and pay for water source on jobsite** (i.e., fire hydrant with valid water meter and/or water permit, 2,000 gallon capacity water truck, or other approved source at a minimum rate of 200 g.p.m. and/or at a minimum vertical height of 14 feet (for water towers or stands)). We'll require approximately 1,600 (2,000) gallons of water for an estimated 10,400 SQFT of Hydromulch. **If water isn't made available on jobsite, this bid-proposal is invalid.**
- 8) General Contractor to provide good, drivable truck access to each site to be treated with Erosion Control (Dry Seed) (SQFT), with Hydromulch and with Compost.
