Dear Mr. Mordhorst:

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) received the attached Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Commitment form for Contract No. 11-406604 from Hazard Construction Company (Hazard). Caltrans established a DBE goal of 8.0 percent for this project. Hazard initially claimed a DBE commitment of 8.30 percent of the total bid amount.

The Office of Business and Economic Opportunity, Contract Evaluation Branch (CEB), conducted an evaluation of the DBE documents submitted by Hazard. The CEB determined that Hazard listed (for credit toward the DBE goal) LMS Transport (LMS) to provide Asphalt Oil in the amount of \$134,334.90. Hazard counted the transportation portion of the material supply at 100 percent. The Code of Federal Regulations, Title 49, Section 26.55(6)(2)(i), states, "If the materials or supplies are purchased from a DBE regular dealer, count 60 percent of the cost of the materials or supplies towards the DBE goals." Therefore, CEB reduced the amount Hazard could claim towards LMS's participation from \$134,334.90 to \$131,031.00. The total dollar amount counted towards the DBE goal is \$605,558.00 or 8.26 percent of the total bid amount. As such, the certified participation amount fell short of the stated goal; however, CEB did determine that Hazard made a good faith effort to meet the goal.

Hazard counted the transportation portion of the material supply to be provided by LMS at 100 percent. Bulk supply transactions are to be counted at 60 percent pursuant to 49 CFR § 26.55(e)(2)(i). Therefore the amount counted towards the goal for LMS was corrected from a claimed amount of \$134,334 to \$131,031.
