The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) received the attached Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Commitment form for Contract No. 12-0H20U4 from West Coast Public Works, Inc. (West Coast) on August 17, 2014. West Coast listed Miranda Logistics (ML) as a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) subcontractor to supply and deliver gravel for this project and claimed \$120,920.00 towards its DBE participation.


Pursuant to the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 49, Section 26.55(6)(2) (i), which states, "If the materials or supplies are purchased from a DBE regular dealer, count 60 percent of the cost of the materials or supplies toward DBE goals."

Upon review of this DBE Commitment form, The Office of Business and Economic Opportunity, Contract Evaluation Branch (CEB), determined that West Coast's calculations did not take into account the 60 percent credit that is applied to the cost of trucking/materials/supplies, in this case gravel mulch, provided by DBE suppliers. As a result, the CEB staff reduced ML's claimed participation from \$120,920.00 to \$103,880.00.

This determination did not adversely impact West Coast's efforts to meet the DBE goal for this project.

It was discovered that Miranda Logistics incorrectly submitted their supply participation for the gravel. As per regulations, only 60% of supply can be counted towards the DBE goal. CEB reduced that amount from 100 to 60 percent.
