

CONDITIONS:

Purchaser, without charge to the Seller, shall provide **adequate working lights for night work**, access roads to where material is to be placed or hoisted, traffic control, grades, lines, ramps, racks, templates, supporting templates, drinking water and sanitary facilities that Seller may require, provide space for delivery and storage of steel accessible to bobtail or semi-tractor trailer truck deliveries and adjacent to place where steel is to be used or hoisted. Field measurements, where required, to be provided by Purchaser. All safety barriers and/or plastic caps are the responsibility of the Purchaser. Delivery and Installation will meet job requirements based on conventional construction, receipt of complete plans and specifications, adequate schedules to which seller is a party and ten work days advance notice on job material and manpower requirements.

Proposal based on:

1. Standard eight-hour day, five-day week.
2. Purchaser, without charge to Seller, shall provide hoisting, lowering footings, decks and/or power placing walls, spread footings, poured decks, in place with fully operated crane.
3. Should the Owner not withhold or reduces the amount of retention held on progressive payments, the same percentage or reduction shall apply to Rouch Rebar.
4. Approval for pouring or embedment of rebar in concrete, shall terminate the Seller's responsibility for that portion of the work.
5. In the event of schedule delays caused by Purchaser or other subcontractors, the Seller will be allowed to reschedule work in accordance with manpower availability not to exceed 48 hours.
6. The cost of ironworker show-up time when work scheduled by Purchaser is not ready will be for Purchaser's account.
7. Purchaser shall not form starter walls before reinforcing steel is installed or have anything across footings where rebar is to be installed, and screeds or stakes are to remain clear if we are to install mesh in slabs.
8. No splices in reinforcing bars will be furnished for contractors' convenience, other than shown on contract drawings.
9. The Seller shall not be responsible for the replacing of steel that has been displaced by others, or for additional construction laps, cleaning or sandblasting of steel made necessary due to operation of others.
10. Payment for materials (reinforcing steel, mesh, etc) due within 30 days after delivery to jobsite.
11. Wet-stamp on shop drawings by Civil or Structural Engineer to be provided by Purchaser.
12. Re-detailing and/or estimating resulting from design changes shall be billed at the rate of \$69.00 per hour.
13. This Quotation, in it's entirety, is to be incorporated into any subcontract between Purchaser and Rouch Rebar.
