The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) received the attached letter dated November 8, 2014, from Dreambuilder (Dreambuilder), protesting Highland Construction, Inc.'s (Highland) and Peterson-Chase General Engineering Construction, Inc.'s (Peterson-Chase) bid. Dreambuilder alleges that Peterson-Chase listed Mallard Construction, Inc. for Bid Item 3 (Traffic Control) for 100% and at the same time claimed Quality Traffic Control (Quality) on the DBE Commitment form to provide impact attenuator vehicles (and the operator); claimed DBE credit for Quality for \$89,250; did not provide a written quote confirmation from Swala Equipment; and Item 38 (Mobilization) was listed twice on the Subcontractor List form. Dreambuilder requests that Caltrans find Peterson-Chase's bid nonresponsive.

Please provide your response to Dreambuilder's protest no later than November 20, 2014.

We are submitting formal bid protest for Contract # 12-0L92U4.
We are 3rd lowest bidder on this project and 1st lowest bidder is Highland Construction Inc. and 2nd bidder is Peterson-Chase General Construction Inc.
We have following protest for their submitted Subcontractor list as well as DBE Summary Form with bid as follows:

For Highland Construction Inc.' bid

1. At the time of bid, 1st lowest bidder, Highland Construction Inc. has listed Orange County Striping Inc. for Striping (Partial) for item # 19 only, but in 24 hrs. submittal of subcontracting list, they made revision and added item # 1 (Lead Compliance Plan) and item # 11 (REMOVE THERMOPLASTIC PAVEMENT MARKING). They failed to list work description at the time of bid.

In subcontracting List, No Revision can be made after bid and if revision is made bid will be declared non-responsive bid. Therefore Highland Construction bid is non responsive bid.


The Subcontractor List must show the name, address, and work portions to be performed by each subcontractor listed. Show work portions by bid item number, description, and percentage of each bid item subcontracted.

2. HCI has submitted quotes with their DBE Commitment Form from their listed DBE subcontractor or Rental Company or suppliers which are procured after bid date 10/30/2014 and they used these quote to terminate the subcontractor who was lowest bidder at the time of bid. They did shopping after bid to gain advantage over other bidders. Quote obtained after bid can't be used get advantage over other bidders.

Since, HCI has not submitted proper quotes with DBE Commitment Form for their listed subcontractor, supplier or rental company to meet DBE goal, Their bid is non responsive bid

All these quote are procured after bid date and these can't be considered as proper quote as confirmation, therefore HCI failed to submit DBE quotes for their listed subcontractor suppliers within 4days time after bid, their bid should be considered as non-responsive bid.

1. Also DBE commitment form states in part, "name of 1st tier DBE subcontractor and their respective item(s) of work listed above must be consistent, where applicable (ie DBE is must be subcontractor), with the names and items of work in the "Subcontractor List" submitted with your bid.

On DBE Summary Form, ACE Fence Co. is being claimed by HCI to perform for item # 9, 10, 27 & 28, ACE Fence Co was not listed on subcontractor List, which is inconsistent, hence HCI's bid need be declared as non responsive bid.

For Peterson-Chase General Engineering Construction Inc.

1. PC on subcontracting List listed Mallard Construction Inc. for Item # 3 (Traffic Control) 100%, but same time they have claimed Quality Traffic Control on DBE commitment to provide Impact attenuator vehicle with driver for \$89,125.00, which is part of traffic control item # 3.
2. Not listing DBE subcontractor on Subcontract List before bid is inconsistent with DBE Commitment form, which is cause to declare non responsive for Peterson-chase General Engineering Construction Inc.
3. Claimed credit for Quality Traffic control for item # 3 for \$89,250.00 should be zero. And New DBE goal % will be 7.26
4. No written quote confirmation is provided by PCI for listed Swala Equipment on DBE commitment Form, therefore PCI's bid need to be considered as Non Responsive bid.

5. Item # 38 (Mobilization) is listed twice on Subcontract list which is more than 100%


