Facts stated herein are as known to the State of California, Caltrans, and are to be verified by the Contractor.

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General Provisions

This site is provided by Caltrans, at the option of the contractor for the disposal of excavated earthen materials and/or AC grindings generated from the Clear Creek Restoration project, located on Route 147 in Lassen County, at PM 0.5/1.2. The earthen material and AC grindings will be deposited at an existing Lassen County Department of Transportation stockpile site on an undeveloped lot (old airport runway) located within Lassen County off of County Road A21.

Contact Information:

This site is owned and operated by Lassen County Maintenance and is gated. The Lassen County Road Maintenance Supervisor, Ray Birky, shall be contacted at least 72 hours prior to the beginning of work at (530) 256-3445 regarding use of this site, operational requirements and coordination.


Material requirements for this disposal site:

- The county will only accept earthen material and/or AC grindings.
- Materials are to be placed within the site limits of this county owned facility in designated areas. Earthen materials shall be stockpiled off the edge of the pavement (old runway), and AC grindings will be stockpiled on the old runway pavement. Lassen County will direct the contractor to designated areas.
- Materials are to be stockpiled in an organized and safe manner, with no risk of instability.

Provisions that apply:

- The contractor bears all liability for damage to haul vehicles and any state provided facility or equipment damaged by the contractor's use of this site. The State assumes no liability for damage to Contractor's equipment. No compensation will be made to the contractor for the handling of non-hazardous man-made objects.
- Existing facilities at the disposal site shall be protected from damage by the Contractor in accordance with Section 5-1.36 "Property and Facility Preservation", of the 2010 Standard Specifications.
- Construction Storm Water Best Management Practices shall apply to this site. No additional compensation shall be made for placement of the erosion control measures at this site. This site must be included in the contractor's Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan.
